\_\_\_\_\_ **Early High School Graduation:** The practice of facilitating completion of the high school program in fewer than four years for the purpose of beginning a post high school career path.

The following items must accompany this form for Early Graduation.

- 1) The Findlay High School Request for Early Graduation Form;
- 2) A letter of request from the student to graduate early, indicating the reasons for the request as well as the target graduation date (due by May 1, preceding the graduation year);
- 3) A letter from parents indicating their permission for their adolescent to graduate early from Findlay High School.
