

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE FOR USE OF SENIOR CITIZEN PASSES

1. A Senior Citizen Pass will be issued to any resident of the District who has attained the age of sixty-five (65).
2. The passes will be available at Findlay High School, only. A picture pass will be given to our senior citizens at no cost for the life-time privileges of attending school activities.
3. Each pass will admit the individual, to whom it was issued, to any activity of the District for which admission is charged.
4. Procedures for use are as follows:
 - A. Activities for which no reserved seats are necessary.
 - B. Reserved seat activities:

When tickets for the activity are on sale at a designated local business, a reserved ticket will be given to the senior citizen upon the showing of his/her pass.
 - C. It will be impossible to reserve a block of seats for holders of Senior Citizen Passes. It must be realized that their use must be limited by the availability of seats.
 - D. When an activity is presented on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights, better seats for normally available on Thursday night.
