

NAMING FACILITIES

From time-to-time, the Board of Education may wish to commemorate a school or District facility by means of a plaque or naming the facility after a person. Such commemoration should be reserved only for those individuals who have made a significant contribution to the enhancement of education generally or the District in particular or to the well being of the District, community, State or nation.

Any employee of the District thus honored must be no longer employed by the district (for a minimum of one [1] year) prior to the Board's selection of his/her name for a plaque or for the naming of a facility.

The Superintendent will be responsible for soliciting names from staff, students, and community and will prepare, for approval of the Board, procedures to follow in naming school properties.

Groups or individuals interested in naming a portion of a building or a facility (athletic field, library, etc.) in honor of a person shall follow the same procedure as above, contacting the Superintendent with the recommendation who will be responsible for making a recommendation to the Board. Such honors shall be reserved for those special few who have made a distinct and/or unusual contribution to the District.
