

STAFF HEALTH AND SAFETY

It is the policy of the Findlay City School District to provide a safe and healthful environment, free from recognized hazards which may cause serious injury to students, employees, and visitors. This is accomplished by maintaining a comprehensive safety, health, and environmental program which involves all district employees. This policy includes but is not limited to accident prevention, safety training, ID badges, etc.

The Board may require an individual examination of an employee whenever, in its judgment, it is necessary to protect the health and safety of students, teachers, and other employees. Whenever the Board requires an employee to submit to a physical examination other than an examination required by law, the Board will assume the cost of the examination. All health examinations required of employees will be made by one of the physicians approved for this purpose by the Board.

Any employee who receives an injury while at work must immediately report this injury to his/her supervisor and request the necessary forms to make the formal report of the injury within 48 hours (use Form 7.02f).

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
