

PROFESSIONAL STAFF CONSULTING ACTIVITIES

The Board considers teaching duties in the District to be full-time employment. Educational consulting work with other agencies or school districts, however, may be a rewarding experience in terms of professional growth for talented and experienced professional staff members. Such involvement also recognizes the District's obligation to the greater educational community.

All absences for consultation work will be approved by the Superintendent and will not normally exceed two (2) days at any one assignment. The agency or school district involved will be asked to pay to the District the cost of a substitute teacher. Inability to do so will not preclude the Superintendent's ability to grant the leave.
