

SUMMER SCHOOLS

The District will, when feasible, sponsor a summer program providing opportunities for enrichment and remedial instruction for students in Grades 1 through 12 and, at the secondary level, for expansion of programs and acceleration.

Tuition fees for resident and non-resident pupils shall be charged, subject to Board approval, except as such programs are funded by the federal government or other outside agencies. Students residing in the District shall have enrollment priority over non-resident students requesting summer school courses.

The established course of study may be modified to meet the needs of summer school students. The administration shall have the right to cancel announced summer courses for which there is not sufficient enrollment and to refund fees. Remedial courses at elementary levels and make-up and review courses at secondary levels shall provide opportunities for students to qualify for promotion and/or credit in areas and subjects where previous work has not met promotional/credit standards. Courses provided for the purpose of permitting students to expand their programs shall meet the credit/instructional hour requirements for summer school courses as established by the Ohio Department of Education.
