

STUDENT PERFORMANCE/TRAVEL

The Board encourages student performance groups to maximize their opportunities to perform before a variety of audiences within the following guidelines:

- a. Distances of performances should be minimized, preferably within the community or state of Ohio such that overnight trips occur rarely.
- b. Expenses of travel will be born by regular Board Funds appropriated for such purposes, or student activity account funds may be utilized if stated in the purpose clause. Students may contribute.
- c. Performances are strongly encouraged to be scheduled at times which do not cause students to miss classes or days of school. On occasions where performances require school time, advanced planning must occur and written permission of the principal must be obtained in advance.

In the event groups are invited to perform at distant locations which entail considerable expense, travel, and school days to be missed, the director must obtain written permission of the principal and superintendent prior to making any plans, conducting fundraisers, or informing students and/or parents of the proposed trip. Approval shall be given only where an educational benefit may be garnered by the students and funding required is within reason.
