

FOREIGN-EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The Board of Education establishes the following policy regarding the Student Exchange Program. Exchange programs that wish to place a student at Findlay High School must meet and continue to meet standards as set forth by the Principal of Findlay High School.

Exchange students must follow the “Illegal Immigration Reform and immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996,” Pub.L. 104-208. This law states that nonimmigrant foreign students who come to the United States without their parents under F-1 visas must pay the local educational agency that administers the school that they are attending for the full unsubsidized per capita cost of the education for the period of the student’s attendance, which may not exceed twelve (12) months. However, the Board of Education may waive tuition for foreign exchange students who are participating with locally recognized community based non-profit or educational organizations.
