

**RESOURCE SPEAKERS**

Teachers are encouraged to invite guest speakers to discuss a particular subject with their students under the following conditions:

- A. The subject of the presentation supports the course of study in that class.
- B. The subject is presented in an unbiased or unprejudiced manner. (Speakers representing several sides of an issue may be used.)
- C. The speaker(s) will not tend to disrupt the school's educational program.
- D. The information to be discussed is appropriate for the age and maturity of the students.
- E. The speaker shall not promote any specific religion, ethnic or racial group, or political candidate and shall be non-proselytizing.
- F. The teacher shall remain in the classroom during the entire presentation in order to provide appropriate follow-up.

The principal shall approve the visits of all guest speakers and may seek permission to record the presentation by audio or video tape for use with other classes.
