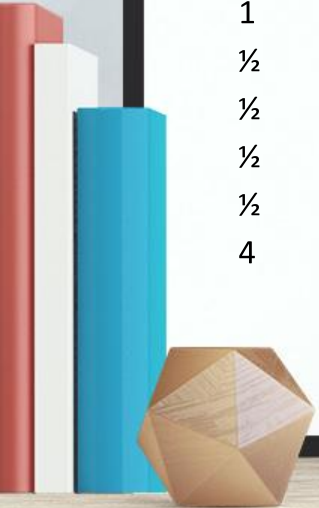
- *Clerical error/class size imbalance (i.e, no English class, conflict)

3 Graduation Options

FHS Class of 2019 and beyond

1

Ohio State Test

Earn at least 18 points on seven end-of-course state tests. End of-course tests are:

- Algebra I
- Geometry
- American Govt.
- American History
- English I
- English II
- Biology

Each test score earns you up to five graduation points. You must have a minimum of **four** points in math, **four** points in English and **six** points across science and social studies.

2

Industry credential and workforce readiness

Earn a minimum of 12 points by receiving a State Board of Education-approved, industry-recognized credential or group of credentials in a single career field and earn the required score on WorkKeys, a work-readiness test. The state of Ohio will pay one time for you to take the WorkKeys test.

College and career readiness tests

Earn remediation-free scores in mathematics and English language arts on either the ACT or SAT. The Ohio Department of Higher Education works with Ohio's universities to set the remediation-free scores for the ACT and SAT tests. Periodically, for a variety of reasons, these scores may be adjusted. The most up-to-date information regarding remediation-free scores can be found on the Department's graduation requirements webpage.

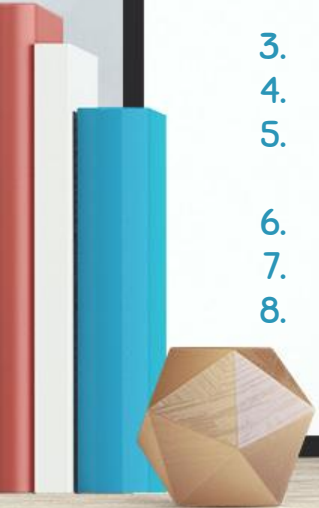

ACADEMIC HONORS DIPLOMA

Students must meet 7 of the 8 criteria:

1. 4 credits English
2. 4 credits Math (include Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, and another higher level math or 4 year sequence)
3. 4 credits Science (including 2 advanced science credits)
4. 4 credits Social Studies
5. 3 credits Foreign Language (same language or 2 units in each of 2 different languages)
6. 1 credit of Fine Arts
7. GPA of 3.5 on 4.0 scale (7 semester GPA)
8. 27 or greater on ACT or 1210/1280 or greater on SAT (depends on year of test)

EXTRACURRICULAR ELIGIBILITY

1. You must pass be enrolled in and earn passing grades in a minimum of 5 full or half credit courses during the previous grading period
2. Maximum of 1 F permitted each grading period
3. At least 1.5 GPA each grading period

*Eligibility is determined by the previous grading period

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP)

CCP is an opportunity for students in grades 7–12 to earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or universities. The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options to college-ready students

Taking a college course from a public college or university is free. That means no cost for tuition, books or fees. If you choose to attend a private college or university, you may have limited costs.

School districts MUST provide counseling services to high school students and their parents/guardians PRIOR to participating in the CCP program, including risks and consequences.



COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP)

Students must notify the district prior to April 1st of the preceding academic year to participate: (LINK–made available on February 1st)

Process begins with Parent Information Meeting:
January 29, 2019

Students have two choices for CCP course offerings:

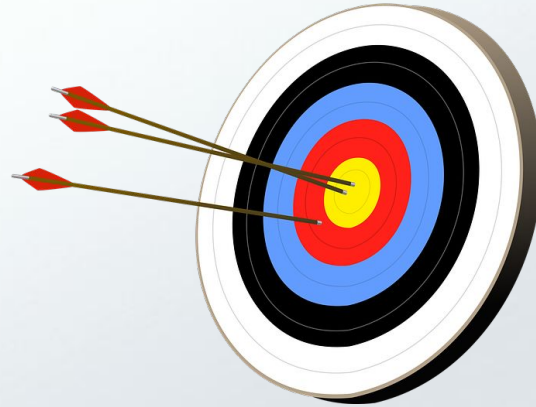
1. On-campus (in-house) courses offered at FHS through various colleges
